Notes:

- A subscription fee will be charged on a per SIM/vessel basis per month for a minimum duration for at least 12 months, except for FBB.COM Plan, where the minimum duration will be one month.
- Subscription and allowance for the first/last month/period will be pro-rated.
- Should a SIM be suspended, then the subscription charge will continue to be applied.
- When a user deactivates a subscription before the end of the minimum duration period, a charge relating to the outstanding subscription (i.e. the remaining portion of the minimum duration period at the monthly rate) will be made and this will be the lesser or the outstanding subscription for the remainder of the minimum duration period or the maximum terminations charges as follows:

•The communication sessions in the "Data transmission over the Internet» (IP-traffic) are formed on the basis of the connections to the network. Such a formation is necessary for the implementation of the IP-traffic monitoring and cost calculation. Parameters of the formation of the communication sessions are as follows:

- The achievement of traffic volume - 2 MB;
- Duration of continuous connection – 12 hours;
- Disconnect of the communication session.

• The duration of each communication session is rounded up in the following increments:

- «Telephone», «ISDN, Fax, Voice 3.1 kHz» - 15 seconds;
- «Streaming IP» - 5 seconds;
- «StandardIP» - 0,0195 Mb

• Minimum paid traffic for each communication session:

- «Telephone», «ISDN, Fax, Voice 3.1 kHz» - 30 seconds;
- «Streaming IP» - 30 seconds;
- «Standard IP» - 0,0977 Mb.

•The total cost of telecommunications services per each SIM-card is settled as the sum of the costs of each communication session, indicated in the CDR detail. The cost calculation of each communication session is made in accordance with the rules of mathematical rounding up to 2-decimal digits. The total cost of services (the invoice amount) for the billing period is defined as the sum of all final costs of communication services on each SIM-card.

•Subscriptions will continue to be charged after the minimum duration period has expired; this means that a SIM which is on a particular Package Rate Plan will continue to be charged at that subscription rate until a service order is received to either deactivate the SIM or to move it onto another Package Rate Plan. No new minimum duration period will be applied once the original minimum duration period has finished.

•VAT is not included.

***AYCE terms, conditions and fair use policy**

1. General

This section provides the Terms and Conditions relating to FleetBroadband All You Can Eat Plan ('AYCE'). This plan is targeted at end users who require FleetBroadband to support high data volumes typically for internet access which may be for all or part of that customer's fleet. This plan provides the opportunity of a fixed monthly cost under the Fair Use Policy ('FUP') as detailed below. The continued offering of this AYCE plan may be withdrawn at any time at Service Provider's absolute discretion with 30 days' notice.

The All You Can Eat plan will close to new activations from 1st April 2015

2. Charging basis

This AYCE plan is focused on supporting internet, and only Standard IP traffic is included in the monthly fee. Usage of any other services, such as Voice, Streaming IP, ISDN or SMS will be charged in accordance with rates specified in this document. (annex 1)

3. Fair Use Policy

As the Inmarsat network is a contended network, Inmarsat employs a Fair Use Policy ('FUP') to ensure that all users behave in a responsible way and to ensure that they benefit from access to the network. AYCE is focused on use of the FleetBroadband service for the provision of an internet capability onboard ship and for applications such as internet access, email and Instant Messaging.

3.1. Only approved types of traffic

Vessels must not use high bandwidth applications or activities such as:

- Peer to Peer file sharing such as BitTorrent, DirectConnect, e-Donkey, FastTrack, Kazaa, Gnutella, Open FT and any other current P2P clients;
- Mainstream un-optimized commercial Voice over IP clients such as Skype;
- Movie and music downloads (incl. MP3/4 content);
- Broadcast or Peer to Peer streaming (including mainstream video sites such as YouTube and internet radio);
- Large updates e.g. System OS upgrades; or
- Any traffic deemed inappropriate or detrimental to the Inmarsat network.

3.2. Antivirus

It is recommended that an antivirus, anti-spam and anti-spyware policy including optimized updates should be employed to prevent unnecessary unwanted traffic or PC corruption.

3.4. Tamper proof

The underlying equipment used for traffic optimization and execution of the Fair Use Policy must be tamper proof and inaccessible to the crew.

3.5 Equipment

AYCE plan is available only for type-approved FBB500 terminals.

3.6 Inmarsat Service Aware Control and Charging (SACC)

As an additional measure of traffic control Inmarsat will use its SACC technology. It measures traffic volume for each SIM with AYCE rate plan and regulates Quality of Service available to that SIM. Service will not be stopped, but Quality of service can be significantly lowered in case of SIM generates excessive, in Inmarsat's opinion, traffic. Quality of service will be restored to default in the beginning of the next month.

3.7 No secondary PDP context

IT specialists should be aware that no Secondary PDP context will be available with AYCE plan. This does not affect initiation of multiple Standard or Streaming Primary PDP contexts.
